Creating Effective Structures

- Mission & Vision
 - Helps outsiders understand your team
 - Helps with decisions about taking on new projects
- Student Roles:
 - Subteam/Subdivision Lead
 - o Captain/CEO
 - o Outreach Lead
 - Traveling Team
- Handbook
 - o Commitment to Meetings, Travel
 - Hold all students to common set of expectations
 - Timeliness, Professionalism, Communication/Response Time Standards, etc.
 - Provides transparency/explains how decisions are made and who makes them

Herding Cats


- Competitions
